

QUICK START USING/INSTALLING BIDVIEW

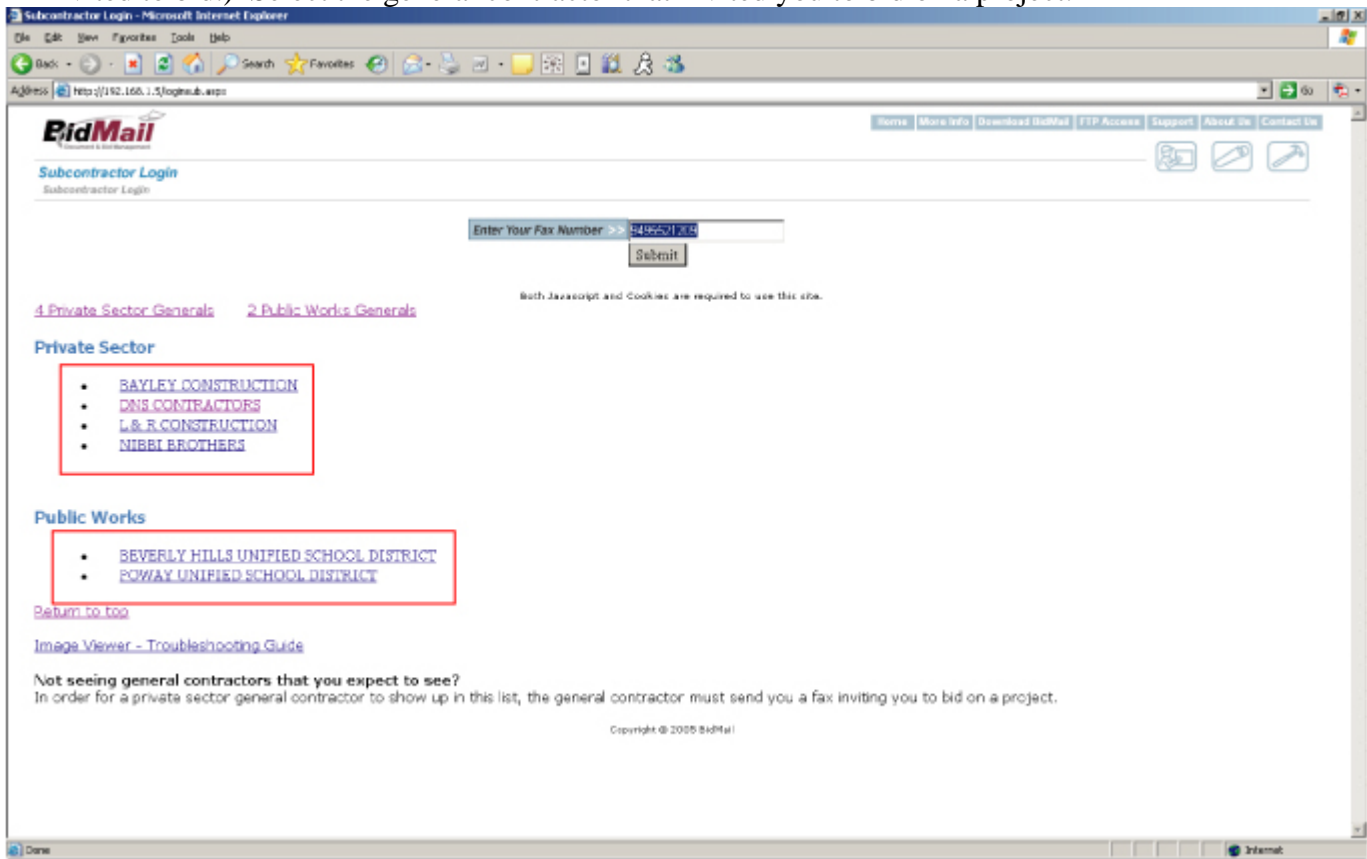
1. Connect to <http://www.bidmail.com/> and select one of the subcontractor links.

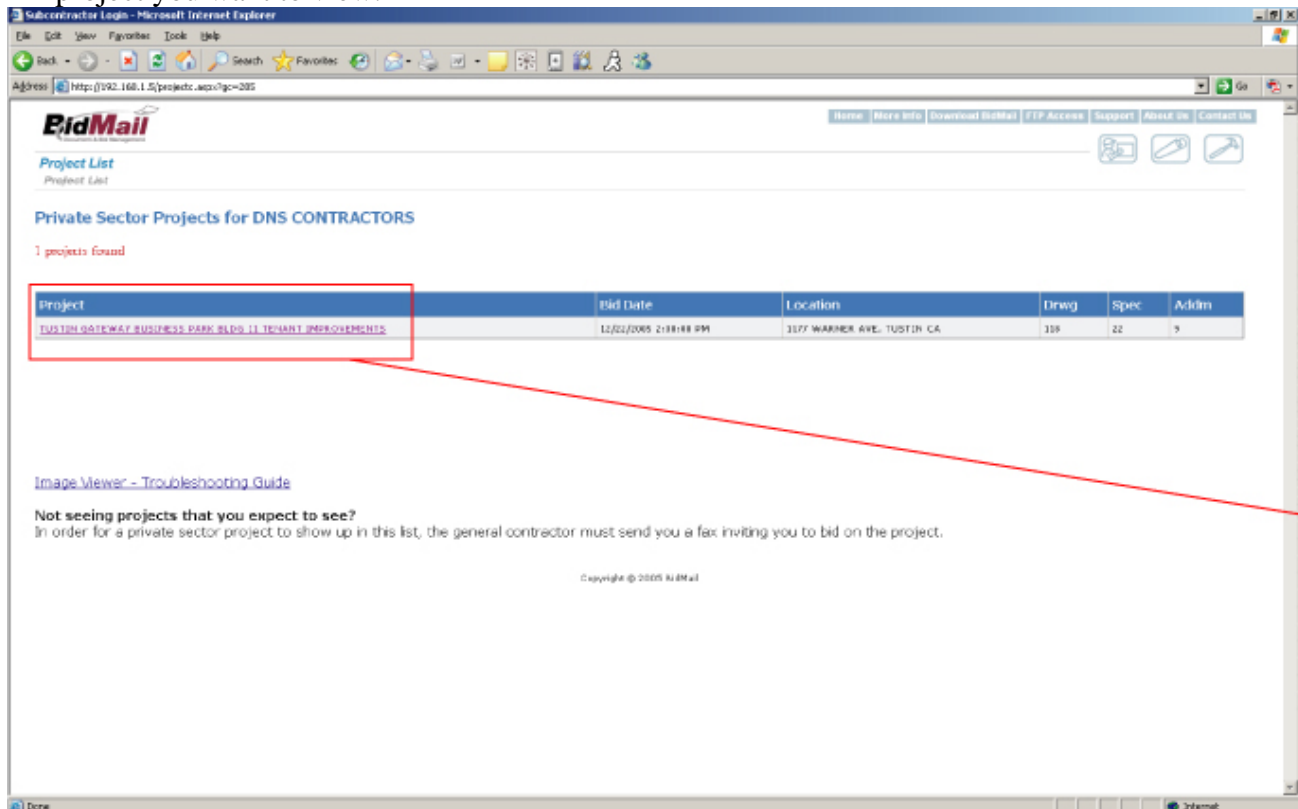
2. Type 10 digit fax number (with or without hyphens).

4. Next you will see a list of projects you have been invited to bid on for that particular general contractor. Select the project you want to view.



5. If you have already installed the viewer the project should display. If you do not have the viewer installed you will see the following screen.

Bidmail Image Viewer - System Requirements

Computer/Processor	PC with 400 megahertz or higher processor clock speed recommended
Operating System	Windows 98 Second Edition Windows Millennium Edition (Windows Me) Windows 2000 Windows XP
Memory	Minimum 128 MB of RAM Recommended
Display	Super VGA (800 x 600) or higher-resolution monitor with 256 colors
Disk Space	Application and Supporting Files require 10 megabytes of disk space. (Images for each project, assuming the user downloads all images for a given project, could require as much as 50 to 75 megabytes of disk space.)
Peripherals	Broadband Internet connection; Microsoft Mouse, or compatible pointing device

Note: The Bidmail Image Viewer installation files are around 10 megabytes in size, and install to your local hard drive. The Viewer connects through an internet connection to download and render TIFF images. These image files are large (often over 1 megabyte in size), therefore the faster your internet connection the faster images will download. If your internet connection is slow, you will need to be patient during the image download process.

Click on install viewer. When prompted click OPEN/ RUN(win XP) to run the setup for BidView Viewer.
