To Be Completed by Subcontractor In Order To Be Placed On Our Bid List

- 1) W. L. Butler Subcontractor Information Form (must be completed in full)
- 2) W. L. Butler Project References and Information Form
- 3) W. L. Butler Subcontractor Safety Questionnaire

Insurance Requirements

Subcontractor must be able to meet W. L. Butler's insurance requirements in order to bid on our projects. A list of our Insurance requirements as outlined in our Subcontract Agreement is included in this package as well as a Sample Certificate of Insurance and Additional Insured Endorsement. You MUST be able to meet these requirements to work on our projects.
